

Eastern Michigan Council – the next level of ABWA


Members from eight Michigan chapters and one Indiana chapter attended the September 14th meeting of the Eastern Michigan Council (EMC) at the Holiday Inn on Plymouth Road justwest of M-23 in Ann Arbor.

Guest speaker Gary Dembs of the Non-Profit Personnel Network presented, "How to stop funding your fundraisers." Gary is an expert on large-scale fundraising in the Detroit area (think the llitches) and a member of the Association of Fundraising Professionals and the Greater Detroit PR Network. He gave the definition of philanthropy as the "love of humankind.'

For fundraisers, he advised asking how much you need, then shooting higher. On donations in general, 90% come from individuals, and corporations and foundations contribute 5% each. Donations can came in the form of time, talent, treasure (\$), or in-kind contributions - such as the items we receive for our auction.

In general, corporations are moving away from events such as golf outings, and matching contributions. Gary recommends establishing relationships with business owners over time, and asking donors for a 3-year commitment for support. He highly recommended being transparent about how the money would be spent.

Gary recommended working with the people closest to you and cultivating existing donors to a higher level of giving. He drew the following diagram:



The election of officers was held, and the 2020 board will be Gail Frahm, Chair, Kelle Hruska, Vice Chair, Heather Naugler, Communications Officer, and Gwendolyn Guy, Financial Officer. The new board takes office on January 1.


