

This event is a favorite at the conference. One woman from the Top Ten will be chosen as the 2026 Business Woman of ABWA, which is ABWA's highest honor for a member.

Karen Kolc has served as our Education Chair for many years – wrangling the scholarship applicants to be sure they submit all of their required paperwork in a timely manner (May 1 deadline). She has recently reported that we have at least six completed applications, the minimum we need to present our two \$2,000 Impact Scholarships. We will also submit a candidate for the \$2,000 Outright Grant for District V (not guaranteed that she will win). Then it is up to the ABWA National Board of Directors to review the applications from all of the chapters across the country and announce the winners.

There is also a reception at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, July 11th (no charge, but please let us know you're coming). The attendees of the reception will be going to dinner at the Los Amigos restaurant, which is across the parking lot from the hotel (each person orders and pays for her/his own dinner).

This special event will feature DVP Renee Clement, and two of the 2025 Top Tens from District V will also speak. Kelly Gray is from the Gem City Charter Chapter in Dayton, Ohio, and Dr. Dawn Kaiser is from the Northeast Sunrise Chapter in Oscoda, Michigan.

There will be fundraising activities that day: a silent auction, an "envelope pull" (\$10 cost with guaranteed \$10 value or more), and a wine cork pull for wines (\$10 cost with guaranteed \$10 value or more). If you wish to donate gift cards, wine bottles, or items for the silent auction (\$25 + value), please let me or Chris Struwe know.

All in all, this event is a fun day and a great way to meet not only other members from District V (Michigan, Ohio, Indiana, Kentucky, and West Virginia), but to also meet members of the National Board of Directors from all over the U.S. I hope you will be able to attend that day!
